- 2. Rashtriya Military Schools are fully residential public schools affiliated to CBSE and function under the aegis of Ministry of Defence.
- 3. Eligibility (a) Age.

Class VI. Candidates aged between 10-12 years as on 31 March 2026 (born between 01 April 2014 to 31 March 2016, both days inclusive) are eligible.
